NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Public Act 110 of 2006, as amended, that a public hearing will be held by the Frenchtown Charter Township Planning Commission on Thursday, February 18, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., or soon thereafter.

In order to maintain compliance with the current Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDDHS) updated Gatherings and Face Mask Order and possible extensions thereof, and in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, the meeting will be held virtually, using an online video call platform.
