The purpose of the public hearing is to hear and consider a request to conditionally rezone an 8.38-acre portion of Parcel #58-07-124-016-00 (1290 N. Monroe Street) from C-2, General Commercial to Conditional C-3, Highway Commercial. The 8.38-acre parcel requesting to be rezoned is located on the east side of the N. Monroe Street, south of Cole Road and more commonly known as the location of the former Kmart and Tire store.
